1. WHAT IS AN RYA Powerboat course?

The RYA (Royal Yachting Association) Level 1 & 2 Introduction to Power Boat Course trains people the basics of Power Boat handling.



Day 1: the course covers the practical aspects of safety in powerboats and basic boat handling.

Day 2: different types of powerboats, basic boat checks, pre launch checks, basic powerboat handling skills at both low and high speed and how to plan a short coastal passage.



Assessment will be conducted on a continual basis and by a small practical and oral assessment at the end of the second day.

The level 2 qualification is strongly advised as it is recognized as the basic minimum standard to drive a powerboat.

2. WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CANDIDATES?

No previous experience needed

3. LANGUAGE

All courses organized by Sudwindsports will be given in English. At the end of the course there will be a written exam in English.

4. COST

2-day RYA Powerboat level 1 & 2 Course (PB): € 300

Accommodation can be arranged in the form of self-catering accommodation shared with other participants of the course on a location close by the Sudwindsports centre in St.Pierre-la-Mer.

5. INSCRIPTIONS – HOW DO I REGISTER?

To book a place on the course you must send, signed and dated:

This form can be downloaded from the Sudwindsports website and needs to be returned to Sudwindsports by e-mail to info@sudwindsports.com or by post to Sudwindsports, 14 Rue du Fer a Cheval, 11110 Salles d'Aude, France.

Upon reception of the inscription forms Sudwindsports will send you an invoice (in British pounds sterling) for the course(s) and accommodation. A place on the course is only definite after reception of a **deposit payment of 25%** of this invoice. For last minute inscriptions full payment is required upon booking. The total course and accommodation costs will have to be paid 4 weeks prior to the course dates. Upon reception of a payment, we will send you the confirmation of your reservation and further details regarding the course.

6. PAYMENTS

The payment can be paid by bank transfer or by credit card, through Paypal, with a 4% surcharge. In case you send an international bank transfer, make sure to accept all bank charges to avoid incomplete payment. Please make the payment in British pounds sterling to avoid any incomplete payments.
